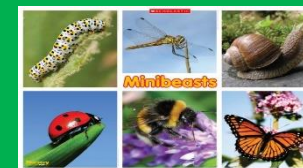




What are minibeasts?



Essential Project Pre-Learning

We will need to know which things are living and how they are different to non-living things. We will have sung songs relating to minibeasts. We will have shared stories about different animals.



Essential Project Learning

- We will learn the names of a variety of minibeasts.
- We will learn the names of different parts of a minibeasts' body and be able to label these parts. We will find out what these parts of the body do.
- We will learn about different habitats and will be able to explain which habitat we are most likely to find minibeasts.
- We will go on a minibeast scavenger hunt to try and find minibeasts that we have been learning about!

Language Dozen

Habitat	Where an animal or creature lives
Antennae	These help some minibeasts to feel where they are going
Wings	Some minibeasts have wings to help them to fly
Thorax	This is the middle section of an insect's body. An insect is also a minibeast
Abdomen	This is the lower section of an insect's body. An insect is also a minibeast
Symmetry	One amazing minibeast, the butterfly, is symmetrical. Butterfly wings have beautiful patterns and colours which are exactly the same on both wings!
Colony	This means a group of minibeasts who live together. Ants and bees live in colonies
Hive	The home which bees create to live in
Cocoon / Chrysalis	The protective case a caterpillar creates for it to turn in to a butterfly
Life cycle	The journey a creature goes on in their life from the day they are born to the day they die
Insect	An insect is also a minibeast. It has a head, thorax, abdomen and 6 legs and sometimes wings
Web	A web is a way a spider catches its food. A spider eats flies and smaller insects which find their way in to its web

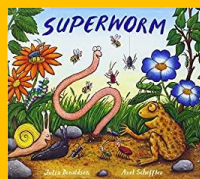
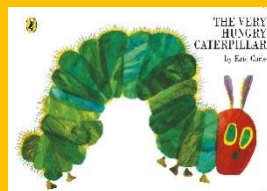
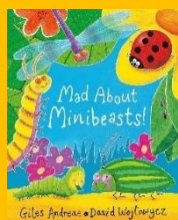
