Essential Project Learning

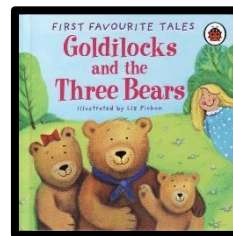
- To know that fairy tales often begin with 'Once upon a time' and end with 'Happily ever after'.

Once upon a time	The opening sentence of most fairy tales.
Happily ever after	The closing sentence of most fairy tales.
