Essential Project Pre-Learning

We will need to know what is meant by 'helping others'. We will need to know that there are different people to go to depending on the help that we need.



Essential Project Learning

- We will learn all about a variety of occupations who we can call upon to help us such as a firefighter, a police officer, a paramedic, a doctor, a vet, a teacher and a librarian.
- We will have the experience to talk to real life people who help us in the community and ask them about their job/role.
- We will discuss why we are grateful to these people and what they do that makes us so thankful for the jobs that they do.
- Together we will discuss which job we would like to have in which we could help others and why we would like to do that job.

Language Dozen

Doctor	A person who is qualified to treat people who are ill.
Firefighter	A skilled man or woman who responds to fires, accidents and other incidents where there are risks to life and property.
Optometrist	An eye doctor who examines, diagnose and treats patients' eyes.
Mechanic	A person who repairs vehicles.
Police Officer	A person who enforces the law, help with emergencies, solve crimes and protect property.
Nurse	Provides care for people in our community.
Lifeguard	A rescuer who supervises the safety and rescue of swimmers at the beach, swimming pool, rivers and lakes.
Vet	A person who is qualified to give medicine or medical treatment to animals to make them better.
Dentist	A person who is qualified to care for our teeth. They look at our teeth and gums to check for any problems. They also make sure our teeth are growing properly.
Postman	A person who delivers post and parcels to our homes.
Paramedic	A person who provides medical care in an emergency. A paramedic travels in an ambulance.
Teacher	A person who provides education for people, to help them to develop their knowledge and skills.

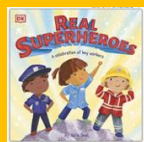
