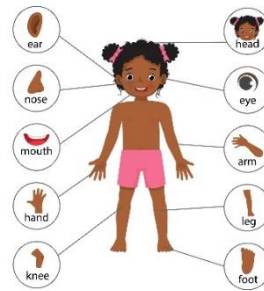


Essential Project Pre-Learning

- We know there are different roles within the community and people who help keep us safe, such as: police, firefighters and nurses.

Essential Project Learning
