I can count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100						
I can find 10 or 100 more or less than any number						
I can recognise the place value of every digit in a 3 digit number						
I can compare and order numbers to 1000

I can read and write numbers to 1000 in numerals and words						
I can solve place value word problems						
Greater depth						
I know multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 50 and 100						
I can use larger numbers and partition these to work out calculations						
I can fluently count in 1's, 10's and 100's						
Number- addition and subtraction						
Secure						
I can add and subtract mentally with a 3 digit number and 1's						
I can add and subtract mentally with a 3 digit number and 10's						
I can add and subtract mentally with a 3 digit number and 100's						
I can use columns to add numbers with up to 3 digits						
I can use columns to subtract numbers with up to 3 digits						
I can estimate the answer to a calculation						
I can use the inverse to check calculations						
I can solve place value problems						
Greater depth						
I can solve addition and subtraction questions						
I can fluently use columns to add and subtract numbers						
Number- multiplication and division						
Secure						
I know multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables						
I can use my known multiplication facts to calculate 2 digit numbers times 1 digit numbers						
I can begin to use a column method to multiply a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number						
I can solve multiplication and division word problems						
Greater depth						
I can make connections between the 2, 4 and 8 times tables (doubling)						
I can derive related facts from the times tables I know						

I can use my knowledge of commutativity to work out facts						
I can use written methods for multiplication and division						
Number- fractions and decimals						
Secure						
I can recognise and show (with diagrams) equivalent fractions						
I can count up and down in hundredths						
I can solve problems with harder fractions						
I can add and subtract fractions with the same denominator						
I can find decimal equivalents for tenths and hundredths						
I can find decimal equivalents to $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$						
I can say what happens to a 1 or 2 digit number when it is divided by 10 or 100						
I can round decimals with 1 decimal place to the nearest whole number						
I can compare numbers with 2 decimal places						
I can solve measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals with up to 2 decimal places						
Greater depth						
I can connect hundredths to tenths and place value						
I can use a number line to connect fractions, numbers and measures						
I know the link between non-unit fractions and multiplication and division						
I can fluently add and subtract fractions with the same denominator						
I can count forwards and backwards in simple fractions and decimals
