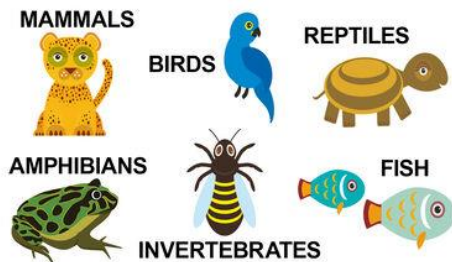


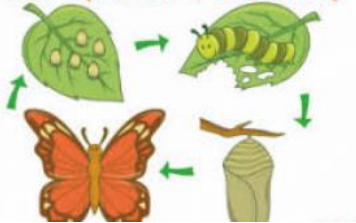
Year 1 Summer Term Project: Why Are Lions Carnivores?

A Few Facts

Nearly all wild lions live in Africa.

Carnivores can only move their jaws up and down.

Cats, dogs, and bears, as a whole, tend to be much smarter than goats, horses, and hippos because carnivores have a larger brain than other mammals.

Language Dozen

Amphibian

Amphibians are animals that live on land and in water. They have smooth, slimy skin.

Bird

Birds have two legs, feathers, wings, a beak and they lay eggs.

Fish

Fish live underwater. They breathe through gills.

Mammal

Mammals breathe air, grow hair or fur, and drink milk from their mum when they are a baby.

Reptile

Reptiles breathe air and have scaly skin. They are cold blooded

Invertebrate

Invertebrates are animals that don't have a backbone. Some have soft bodies, like worms, slugs and jellyfish. Other invertebrates, like insects, spiders and crustaceans, have a hard outer casing called an exoskeleton.

Vertebrate

Animals that do have a backbone. The major groups include fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

Carnivore

Animals that eat meat are carnivores.

Herbivore

Animals that eat plants are herbivores.

Omnivore

Animals that eat both plants and meat are omnivores.

Life cycle

Animals are born, grow, get older and have children; this is called a life cycle.

Zoo

A park where captive animals, often from all over the world, live and are exhibited to visitors.

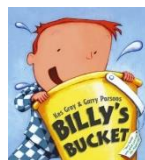
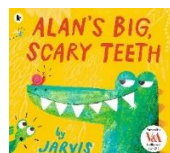
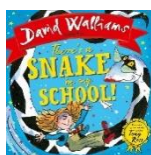
