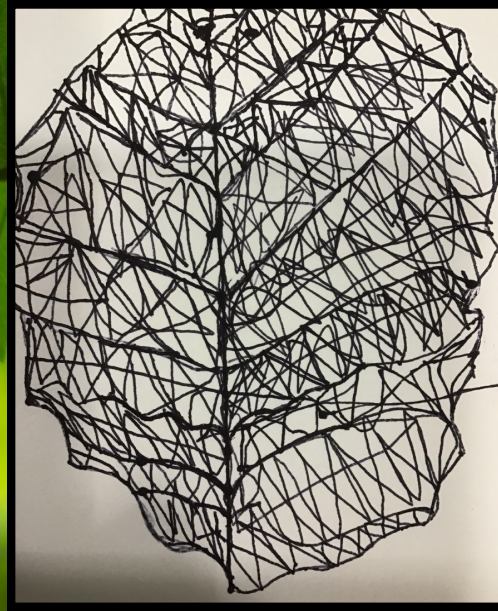
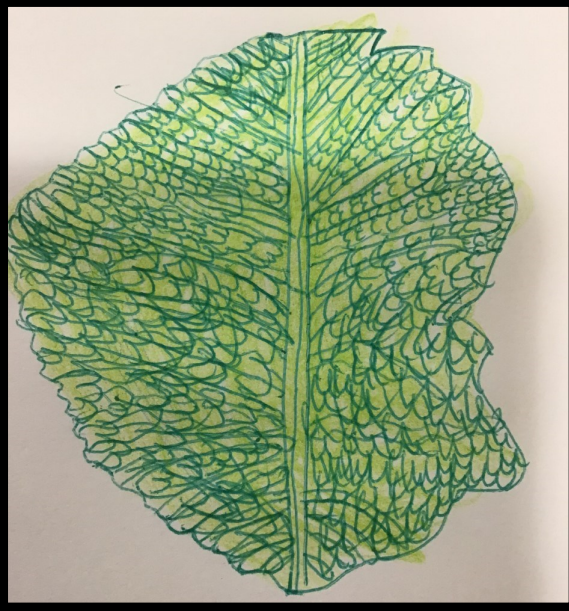

Key Vocabulary



Cartooning— Usually a funny drawing that accentuates characteristics E.g larger eyes.

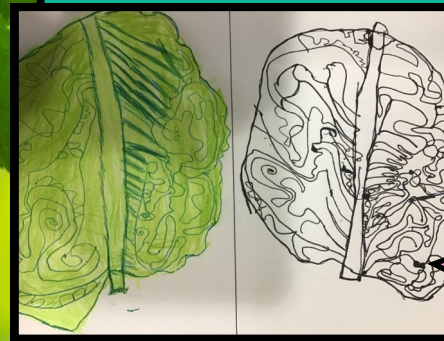
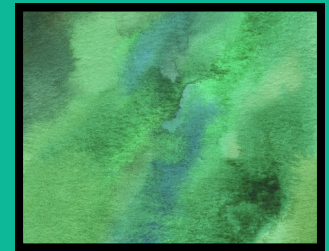
Collage—a type of art work in which different kinds of materials are pasted onto a surface to make a picture. These materials can be anything from paper and photographs, to cloth and buttons.

Leporello—Paper that is usually folded 'concertina style' to create a booklet or leaflet.



Mono-print—printmaking where the print can only be made once.

Watercolour wash—Where you use lots of water with your water-colour paints to cover a large area.

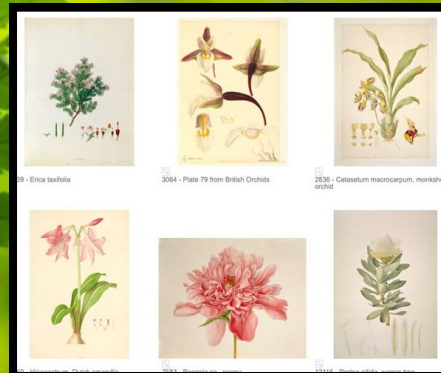
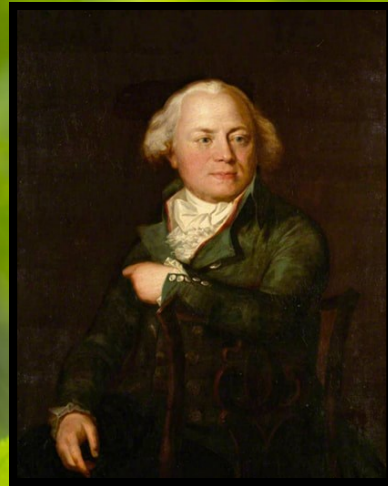

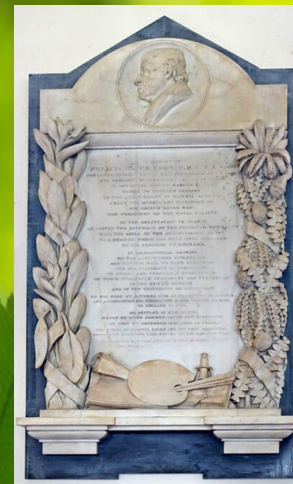
Franz Bauer and Etel Adnan

Key Facts about Etel Adnan 1925-2021

- Artist Etel Adnan had been creating art for over fifty years.
- She made paintings, tapestries using fabric, ceramics using clay... and a special kind of artwork that she called her 'leporellos'.
- She was born in Lebanon. Her mother was Greek and her father Syrian.
- Adnan enjoyed playing with words and spoke many different languages.



Key Facts about Franz Bauer 1758-1840

- He was born in Austria
- He was the first botanical illustrator for the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew. With his brother, Ferdinand.
- He worked at Kew for 50 years.
- His paintings were owned by the King (now the Queen) who gave them to The natural History Museum.
- Franz Bauer is considered to be the greatest botanical artist of all time.
