Attendance - New guidance has come in on attendance following the pandemic. There is an absence request form within the policy – paper copies available on request from the office. Holidays will not be authorised outside of term time unless exceptional circumstances and **absences may incur a fine.**

If they come into school after **8:55** they will be marked as L (late).

If they come into school after **9:10** they will be marked as U (Unauthorised absence).
