Toward the end of last week, the Government published guidelines for schools on the re-opening of schools in September. We understand that many of you will need to plan ready for September and so we are outlining some key points in this letter. More detail will follow.



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- We are looking forward to welcoming all children back to school from Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020
- Children will be kept in “year group bubbles” where possible through the school day.
- Older children in their year group bubbles will be asked to think about social distancing. This already happens in school and children have coped exceptionally well with the guidelines they are reminded about. We know that younger children will be less likely to socially distance and it is acceptable for them not to socially distance in their bubble.
- Staggered start and finish times will be in place for the Autumn Term.
- Movement around school site is based on a one way system and there will continue to be staggered break and lunch times. Assemblies will take place virtually or in year group bubbles during the Autumn Term.
- Enhanced routines in terms of cleaning, handwashing and hygiene will continue throughout the Autumn Term at least.
- Staff have received training on working in schools during the pandemic. There is a comprehensive Risk Assessment which is under constant review according to best practice.

### **Q) What about Breakfast Club and After School Club?**

We understand that some working parents may need support with wrap around provision from September. We want to support you as much as we can with this but must work within the guidelines and will always continue to put the safety of pupils and staff first.

From September, there will be the offer of a “wrap around” hour to support working parents. This will mean that all children have the chance to be in school – in their year group base between 8:00am and 3:30pm. Our extended school **after school** provision will **not** be open initially in September. If you want to take the “wrap around” hour provision – this will be charged at £3 per daily hour and will not include breakfast as children will be based in one of 7 bubble bases. Your child is very welcome to bring in a piece of fruit / breakfast bar etc to have in school.

The “wrap around hour” will be available to book on ParentPay from September and will be on a daily basis as parents require the additional support.
