We have opened this week to Year 6 and it has been great to have them back in the building! I know they have enjoyed it too! Thank you to the staff who have done such a great job this week supporting this cohort of children. Skeleton school (supporting keyworker and vulnerable children) continues as usual until the end of this term.

Nottingham City Local Authority has released a letter stating they are happy for schools to continue the gradual and phased re-opening of certain year groups from Monday 22nd June. This letter can be found on our school website.

From **Monday 22nd June** we will be welcoming back some children into **Year 1** bubbles and from **Wednesday 24th June** we will be pleased to see some children return into **Reception**. Please do not just "arrive" with your child at school. Information has been communicated to each year group and you **MUST** have spoken with school before your child returns. Parents of Nursery children will be contacted next week.

As we predicted, school will NOT re-open to children in Years 2 / 3 / 4 and 5. Remote learning will carry on until the end of the Summer term for these children and your class teacher will make a visit to you delivering your exercise books / PE kit (if it was left in school) and a reading book for you to enjoy and review. Class teachers are also organising a class Zoom call or Showbie Live session so you can meet up virtually as a class before the end of term. We are sorry we will not be seeing you back in school just yet but we are thinking of you and hope you are staying motivated and positive! We will keep you as up to date as we can as decisions are made by government on the re-opening of school to all children.

Please do remember that school will be **CLOSED** to all pupils on Monday 29th June. The last remote achievement letter of the term will be out tomorrow and then I will be aiming to upload virtual assemblies on a Friday starting next week!
