Dear Parents and Carers,

I am just writing a letter at the end of this half term week to update you. As you may be aware, the Government are advising schools to begin accepting pupils from Y6, F2 Y1 and Nursery back into school from Monday 1st June. Schools have been planning for this for the last 3 weeks and as you will have seen - we - at Robin Hood have been planning for a phased re-introduction of children in these year groups.

Today, the Nottingham City Local Authority has directed **SCHOOLS IN NOTTINGHAM CITY NOT** to open to **ANY** year groups (other than children of keyworkers - as has been the case since 23rd March)

I have attached the letter from Nottingham City Local Authority which has been sent to us this afternoon.

We know that some Y6 children were excited to start back and had been preparing themselves for a return to school - we will be sorry not to see them on Monday, we miss them and will look forward to seeing them soon!

At this point, I cannot give you a date when schools in Nottingham City will have the go-ahead of the Local Authority to open to pupils wider than the keyworker group but I will keep you informed. Remote learning will begin again on Monday 1st June and there is a new set of Learning Booklets which will be outside school for you to pick up from next week!
