Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all staying well and finding the positives in this time you are spending as a family at home. There have been some great photos sent to teachers and it is fantastic how busy many of you are keeping and in what creative ways you are entertaining and learning with your children!

Thanks for all your feedback around home learning. We have used this to make some changes to our offer:

PHYSICAL WORK BOOKLETS

From today there are physical work booklets which are available from our school site – feel free to come and collect them as you are out on your daily walk. School site is open between 8 – 5 every weekday. These work booklets are mainly worksheet based and will be updated every 2 weeks. The next edition of work booklets will go out on Monday 1st June and every two weeks thereafter. If you are at any point self isolating and REALLY cannot get to school to collect these – we are happy to post booklets out.



There is a box for each year group – clearly labelled. Enter through the Beckhampton Road gate which is open. Take the year group booklet most appropriate for your child. Email your child's teacher for advice if you are unsure.



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REMOTE LEARNING

You will continue to receive a **weekly email from your child's class teacher with an outline of a weekly timetable**. The resources will then all be accessed via our school website (just click on your child's year group folder). We have tested access to these as much as we can on a variety of devices and feel this system will support all pupils and families best in the weeks ahead.

Y4 and Y5 will continue to access learning tasks via Showbie on their ipads. Parents – you will receive the weekly timetable just like other year groups.

Please do not feel under pressure to print work. We know that you are all - as parents – doing your best to support your child during this time. We also continue to acknowledge that you know your child best and so you will know when to give them some “time out” or when to insist they get on with some learning. If in doubt, as ever... keep them reading!

Please do stay in touch with us – communicate with your child's class teacher regularly. We are trying to celebrate home learning in our weekly achievement letter and also on our school website.

This revised approach to remote learning will start on Monday (11th) for Year 3 and for all other year groups on Monday 18th May.

Feedback:

You can send images of your child's learning to receive feedback from their class teacher. Y4 and Y5 teachers are able to give direct feedback but they will not be feeding back on every activity set.

REMOTE LEARNING (HALF TERM):

Teachers will **not** be sending learning tasks over the Half term holiday.
