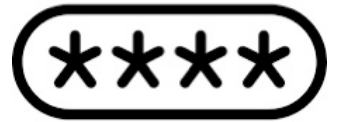


World Password Day

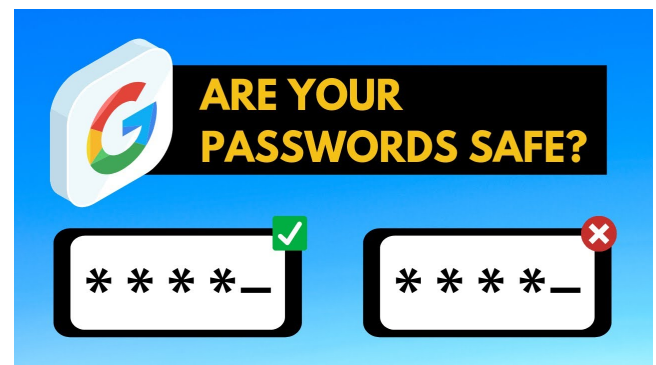

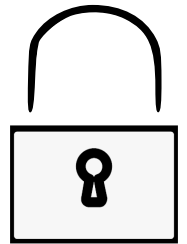
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What would you do in each of these situations? Discuss your answer with your parents.

Situation 1: You are playing a game online and get a message pop up. Someone is asking for your password in return for 2000 gamer points.

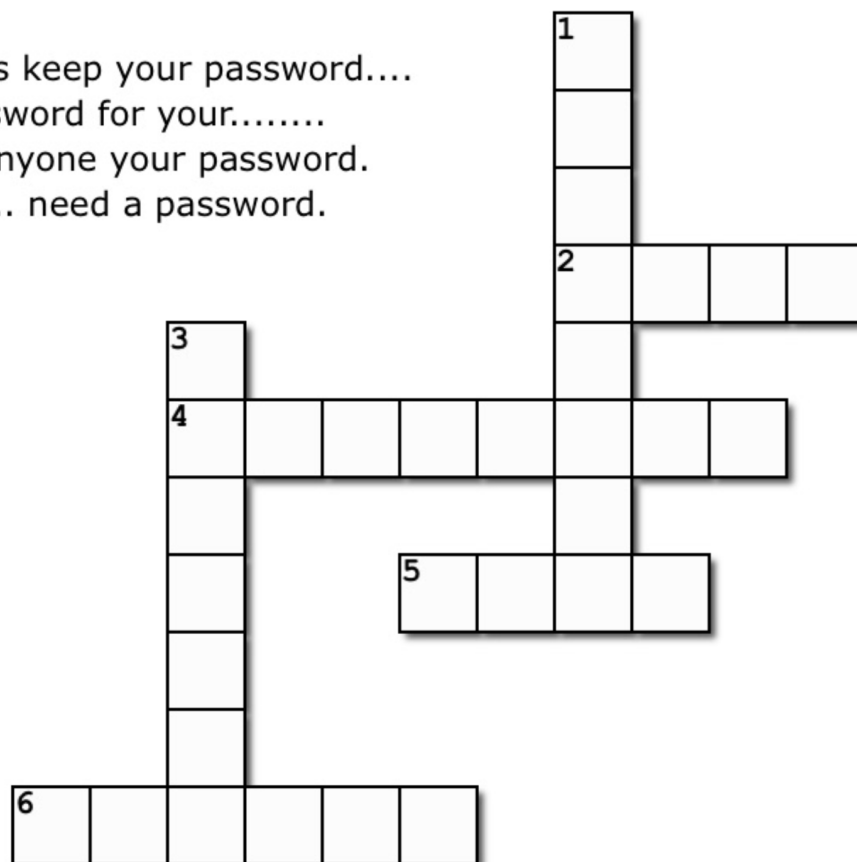
Situation 2: Your friend is going on holiday and they want you to 'look after' their online account. This means that they will be giving you their password.
