up.

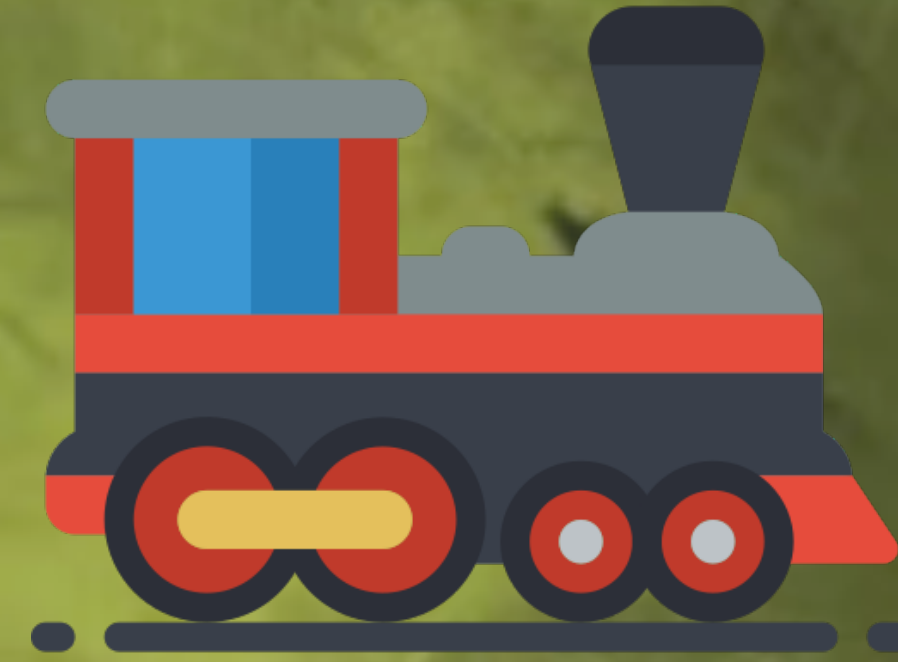


Rationing

Rationing was something that would happen after the war or a big event. People would be limited to food and drinks supplies: a pregnant woman would get more, for it was important for their kids to be healthy born; regular adults would get less than a pregnant woman but a bit more than kids; kids would be limited to healthy stuff as well (no sugary stuff was allowed); soldiers would get the most of food for they were serving their country.



Evacuation



For the children's safety, the British used Operation Pied Piper began in September the 1st 1939. Around 3 million kids had been evacuated. Being transported to a country side for there was less buildings making it less likely to be bomb having it as the perfect home. The amount of children on on the train was impressive: there was 500 kids on a single train.



The Blitz impact
