A GUIDE TO NURSERY



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Welcome!

Before we begin let us welcome you to Robin Hood Primary School.

We hope that you and your child feel a part of our school community very quickly.

This leaflet should answer most of your questions about starting in Foundation 1 (Nursery) but if you have any further queries please do get in touch with us and we will be happy to help.

We offer a broad curriculum in Foundation 1 with a very strong emphasis on **language development**.

In our safe, secure and happy school environment your child will have the opportunity to use all of their senses and learn through play.

We provide a variety of different activities that encourage and challenge children to think, to experiment and to ask questions. There is also a big emphasis on learning to **share** and co-operate with each other.

Your child will also be able to have a drink of milk (or water) and a portion of fruit everyday free of charge.

Foundation 1 Hours:

Morning Session: 8:45am - 11:45am

Afternoon Session: 12:30pm - 3.30pm

Doors open 5 minutes before the end of each session (11:40am & 3:25pm)

IMPORTANT:

-  Please pick up your child on time.
-  If someone different is collecting your child, please let the staff and your child know.
-  Only people aged 16 or over can collect your child.
-  In an emergency, if you get delayed, please telephone the school to let us know so that we can tell your child and look after them until you arrive.

Health & Safety

The following guidelines are in place to keep the school a safe place for all of our pupils:

-  NO jewellery except stud earrings.
-  NO smoking on the school site.
-  NO cars allowed on the drive or on site unless the owner has a disabled badge or by the agreement of the Head Teacher.
-  NO dogs allowed on the school grounds.

Information we need

It is important that all information we hold on your child is up to date.

-  Please tell us about any changes to your contact details or your child's medical needs (eg. new allergies) immediately.
-  We need up to date contact details for you in case your child becomes ill during a session.
-  We do not usually administer medicines except for inhalers. You will need to give full instructions to the staff and have the inhaler named and complete an agreement form which you can obtain from the school office.

You know your child best

We have several schemes running in F1 that help us work together:

-  'Tapestry' - An app to support us sharing what your child is learning about
-  'Learning Logs' - our scheme to encourage a love of reading at home and use of the local library.
-  'Parent Visits' - you will be invited in to come and see what your child is doing in school.
