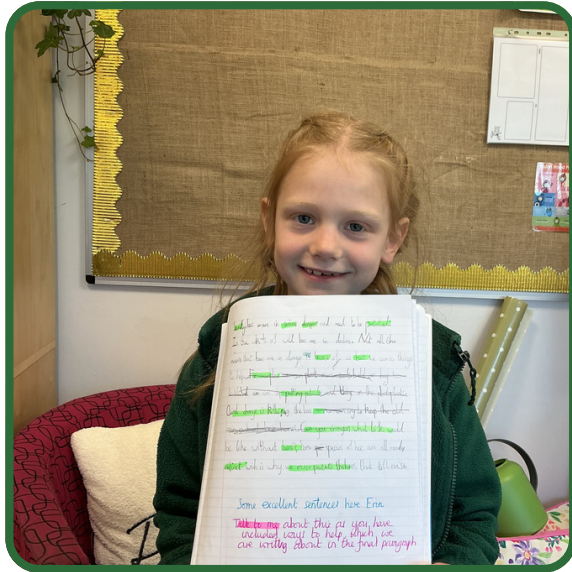

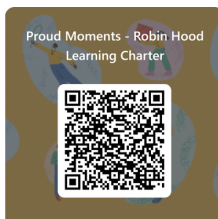

I have popped into classrooms across the week and I have seen some amazing learning - Year 2 have completed some amazing writing about traction man and Year 3 have been writing about saving bees!



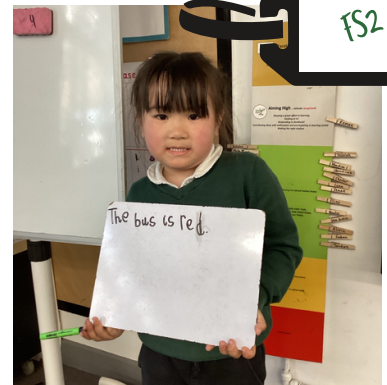

We are half way through the half term already, time flies when you're having fun! In the next few weeks these things are happening across school:

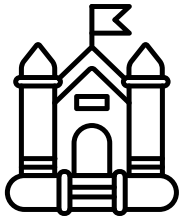
