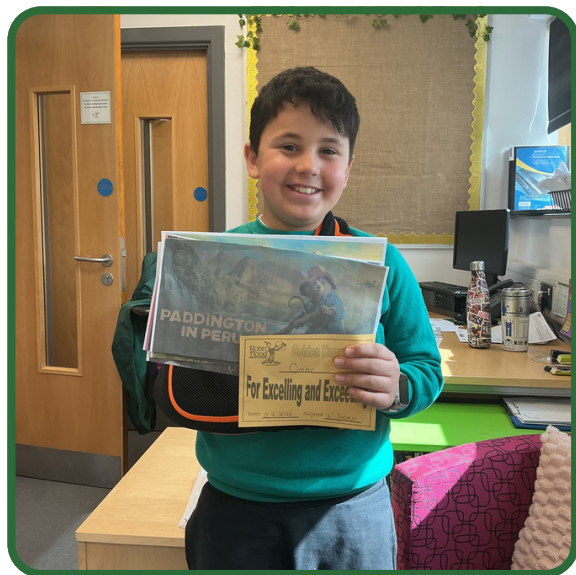

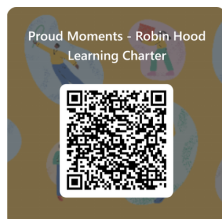

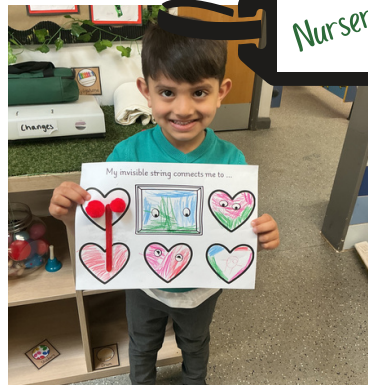
Our Year 5 children enjoyed a trip on Wednesday to Cadbury World and they had a great time! I think the amount of chocolate they returned with really helped.

## Dates for the diary

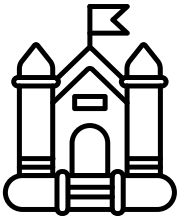
- Year 1 Twycross Zoo trip Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> April

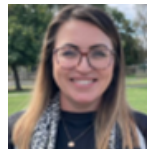
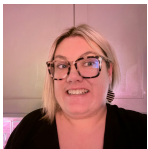

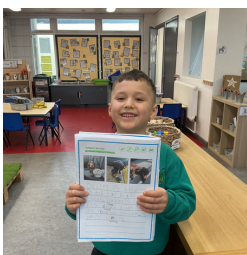


## Safeguarding
